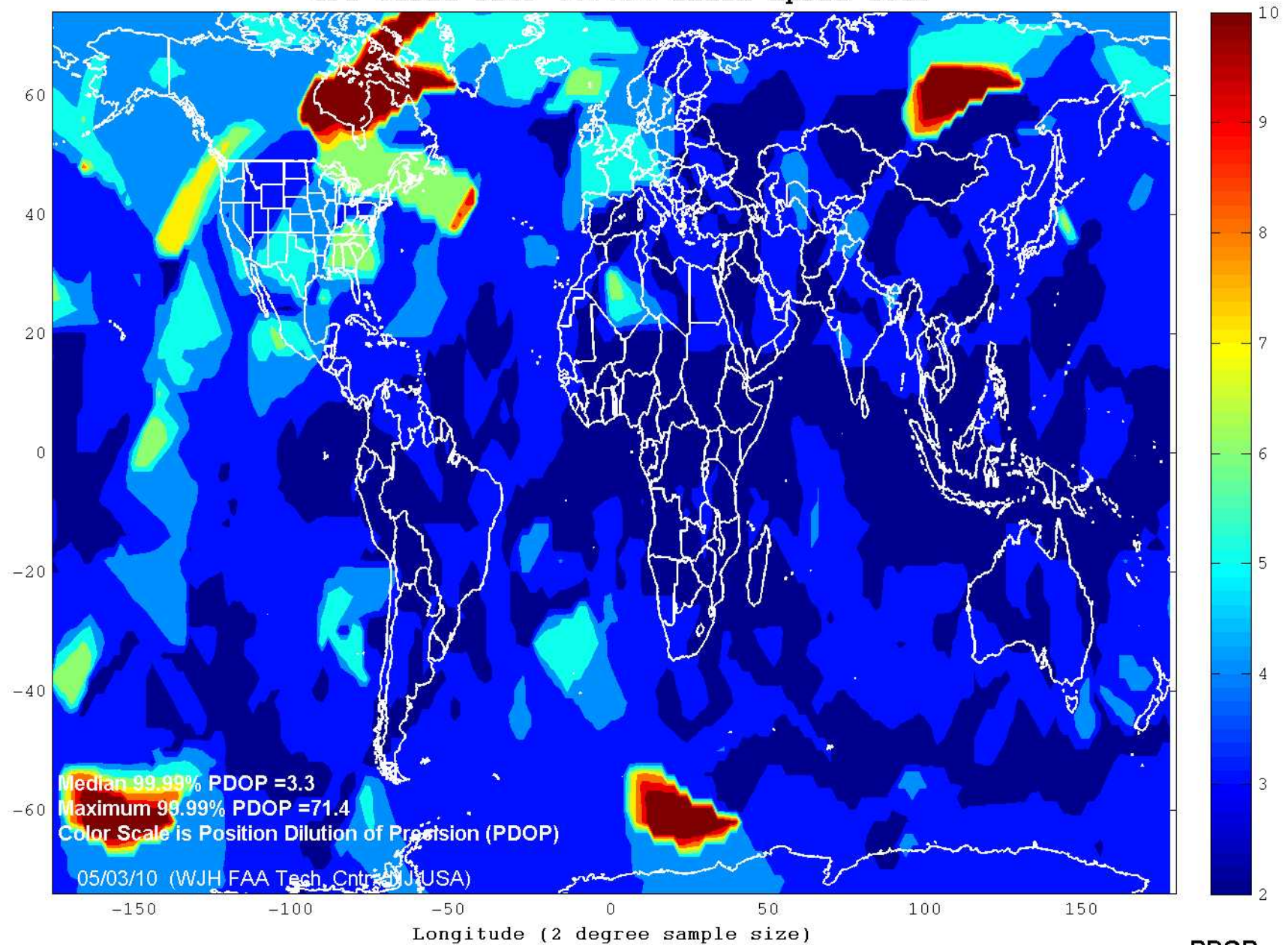

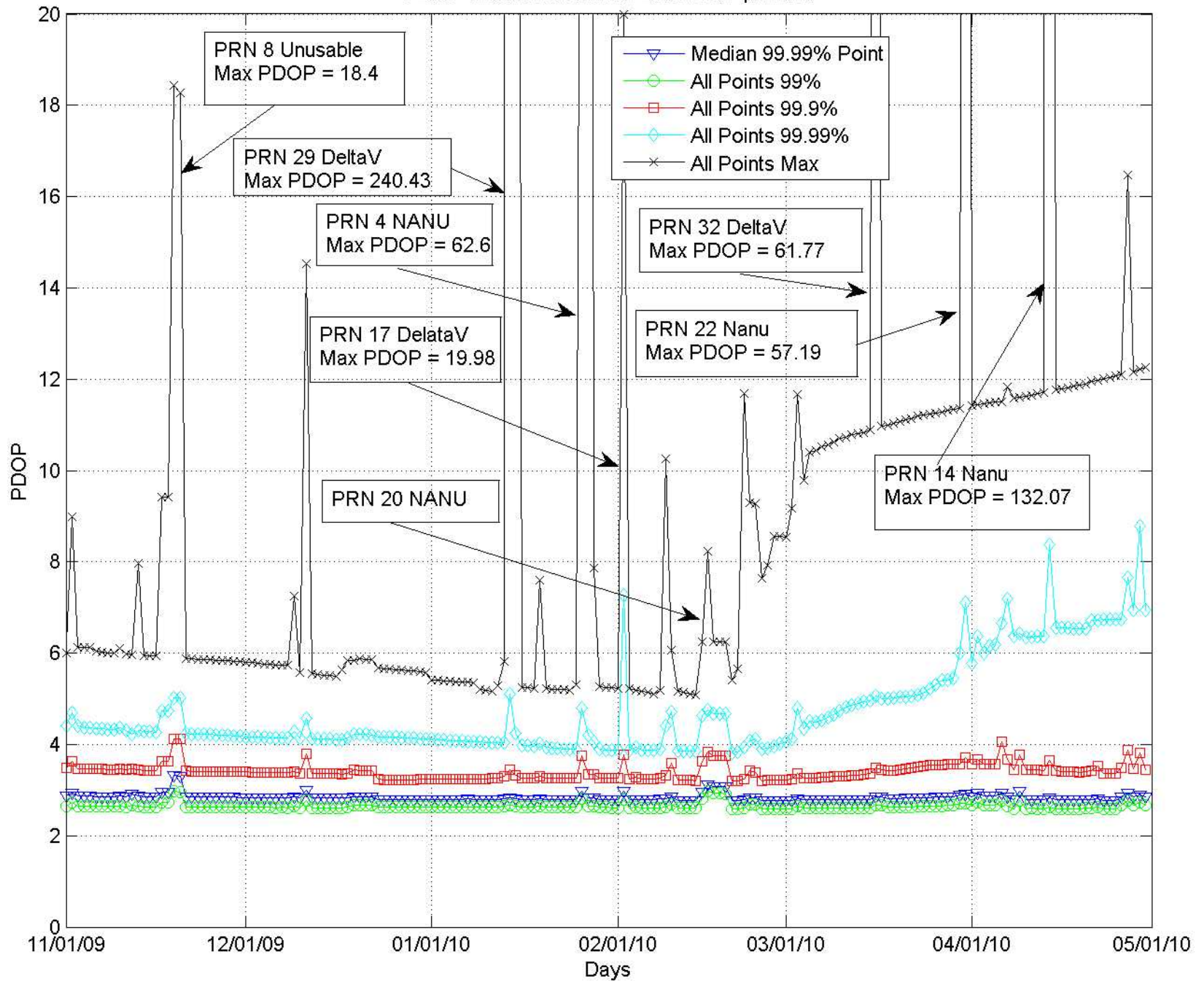

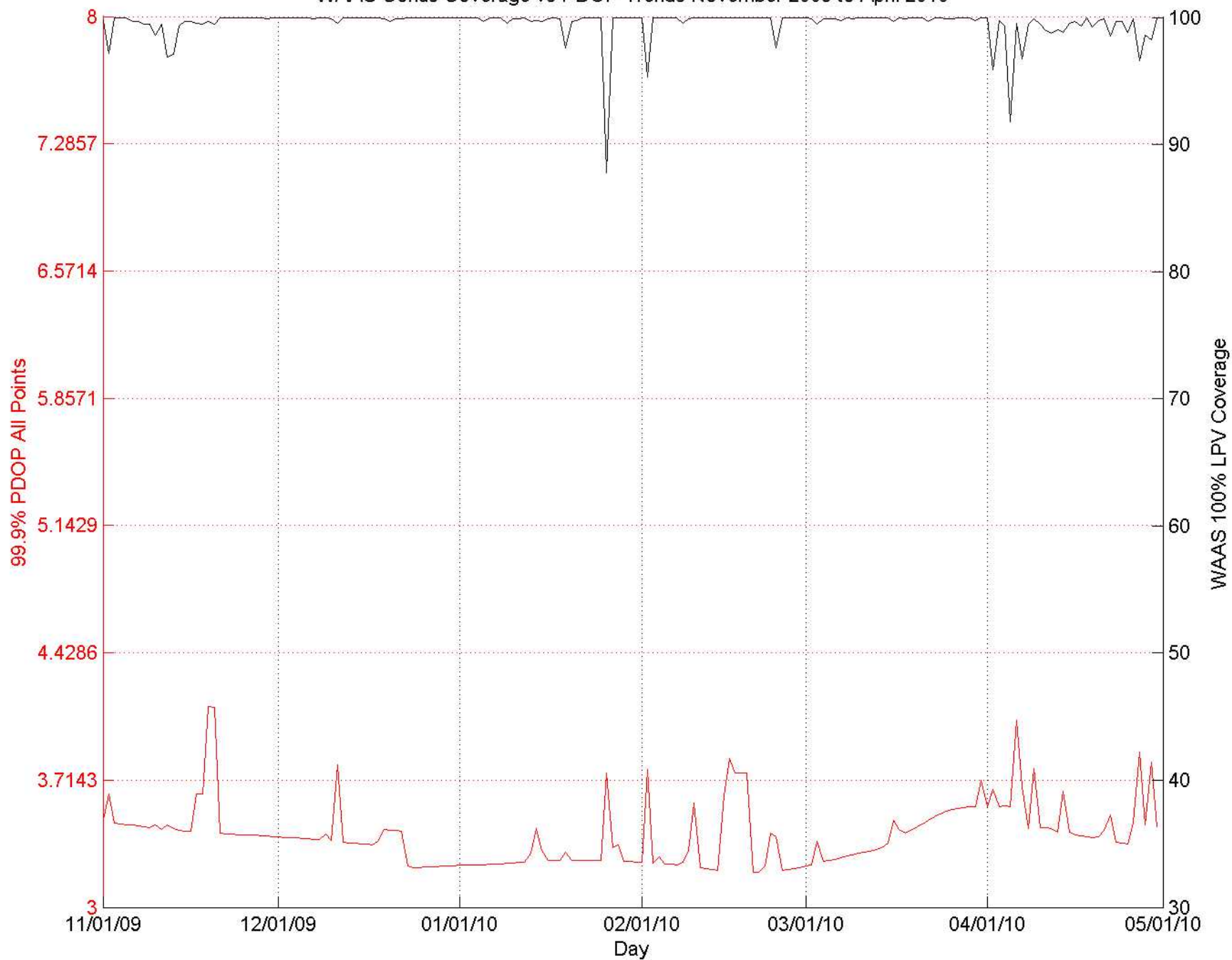
GPS World PDOP 99.99% Index April 2010
